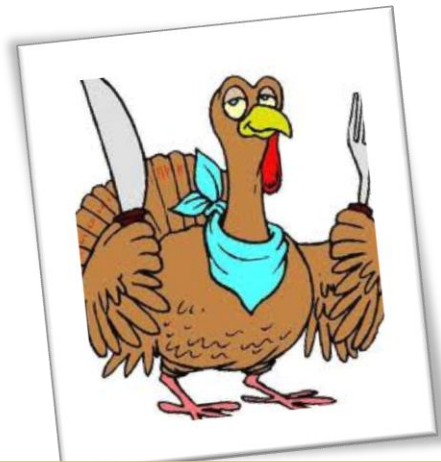
Battle of the Bands: November 18th, 8 PM, Union Hall, free drinks

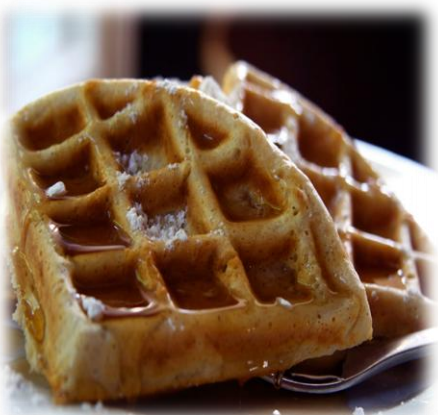

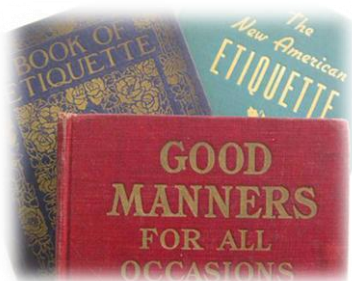
