Welcome and congratulations on your acceptance to LaSalle University!

The Student Health Center is a primary health care facility staffed by experienced Nurse Practitioners that provide health care for acute illnesses to our full-time day undergraduate (residential and commuter) students and all other residential students. The Student Health Center is open Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. when classes are in session during the academic year. As necessary, we provide: prescription medicines and vaccines charged to your tuition bill. If required, lab tests and x-rays can be ordered.

### **What do you need to do by JUNE 30<sup>TH</sup>?**

- ✓ Complete the Student Health History Form – due June 30, 2017
- ✓ Complete the Proof of Vaccines – due June 30, 2017

**\*Failing to complete the mandatory Student Health requirements will result in a Medical Hold that will restrict you from registering for classes for the next semester.**

- ✓ Did you pack your rescue inhalers and/or allergy medications?
- ✓ Do you have a copy of the front and back of your insurance card in your wallet or cell phone?
